

31st Street Bridge Replacement Over the C&O Canal Notice of Long-Term Detour of 31st Street, NW 31st Street Between M Street, NW and K Street, NW Beginning the Week of June 10, 2019

Project Information

The 31st Street Bridge is located in Georgetown and spans the C&O Canal. The bridge is supported on stone masonry abutment walls and an 1867 cast iron multi-column pier. DDOT is replacing the structurally deficient, weight-limited bridge. In the process, the existing historic pier will be removed, restored, and reset.

Long-Term Detour of 31st Street, NW

In order to perform the work, 31st Street, NW - between M Street, NW and K Street, NW - will be closed to through vehicular traffic. The bridge will be closed; however, local traffic, deliveries, pedestrian, and bike traffic will be maintained at all times.

There will be no parking between South Street, NW to the bridge, and from the bridge to M Street, NW. There will be Residential Permit Parking, Zone 2 from South Street, NW to K Street, NW.

The detour will start the week of June 10th and remain in place until the project is completed in the Summer of 2020.
